Our Services

Domestic Violence

As the state-designated provider for DV services in Hudson County, WomenRising provides women and their families with emergency shelter, a 24-hour hotline, counseling services, and court advocacy.

Permanent Supportive Housing

The Village of Families program provides 22 formerly homeless families with permanent housing and supportive services so they can succeed and thrive.

Youth & Family

Crisis Intervention and management, in-home and on-site supportive counseling, parenting education, supervised visitation, family activities, and information referral are all services offered.

Workforce Development

A full-service resource and employment center including assistance with job search, workplace readiness, and industry-specific training programs. Scheduled classes and walk-in services are available.

Healthy Women, Healthy Families

A partnership with Maternal Child Health dedicated to decreasing disparities in healthcare for women and children. A special emphasis is placed on reducing infant mortality rates and improving perinatal outcomes in the community.

What is Domestic Violence?

Domestic Violence is a pattern of abusive behavior where one person in the relationship gains and maintains power and control over their partner by instilling fear of consequences through the use of intimidation and manipulation tactics.
